She becomes a french spie and she passes a lot of secret messages to the resistants, who fight for the France. She does especially her proof fidding informations at the embassy of Italy. Josephine likes to resist the Nazis and she doesn't mind civil disobedience for that. Then, in 1960' she fights racism, using her popularity and defends the rights of blacks in the USA and was also involved in the civil rigths movement. Josephine was the first and only women to give a speach alongside Martin Lutherking, on August 28, 1963. She describes this day like the most beautiful of her life. She says "You know, my friends, that I am not lying to you when I tell you that I entered the palace of kings and quenns, the house of presidents and much more. But I could not enter in hotel in America and drink a cup of cofee and it made me furious."

Josephine was an important woman, she was awarded the Medal of the French Resistance in 1946 and she is inducted into the Pantheon, the November 30, 2021, years after her death, the April 12, 1975.

- If Josephine had not existed, what would France have been
- like? - If she hadn't made herself known, would black women's
